




Preparing Tomorrow's Leaders

UC Davis Summer Pre-College Programs

Growing up in Compton, California, Paris Scott discovered an unexpected interest: riding horses. She learned to ride wtih the Compton Cowboys, an organization that works with horses to provide a positive influence on inner-city youth. After years of practice, Paris joined their junior equestrian show jumping team.

Her talent caught the eye of UC Davis professor Amy McLean, who secured a scholarship for Paris to attend the **UC Davis Summer Pre-College Program** in Equine Science. For two weeks Paris lived on campus, learning skills and knowledge from top faculty. She left with the drive to become a veterinarian, and the dream of some day being an Aggie.

McLean, an animal scientist who teaches in the program, hopes to bring more students like Paris to experience UC Davis, and envisions equine science summer scholarships for Native American and other underrepresented students as well.

Our two-week residential programs invite high-potential high school students to explore a major, live with peers in residence halls, work with brilliant researchers at one of the world's top research universities—and prepare them for college success.

Our summer programs launched in 2017 with 35 participants in four courses. Since the post-pandemic return to campus in 2021, we have grown to 154 students and added bold new courses that equip tomorrow's leaders in our extraordinary facilities.


